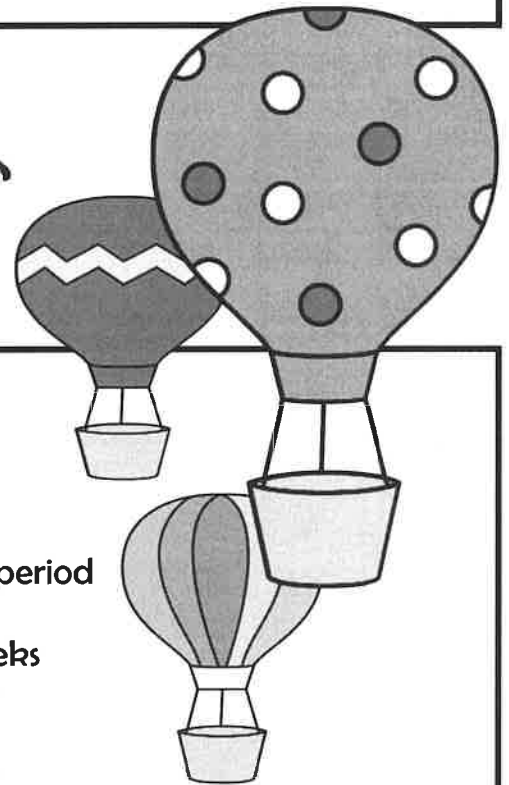
A Note from Ms. Mathis and Ms. Dean
